1. General Remarks

Every statement or information in a paper, essay, review or any other scientific writing that you got from another source, be it a print source or from online, must be referenced.

There are different citation styles you can use. **Important is only that you use one style consistently for your whole work.**

If you make a direct quote or paraphrase, the reference comes directly after.
